

## **IOPS REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON RISK-BASED SUPERVISION**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **1. ORGANIZATION**

The IOPS Regional Workshop on Risk-Based Supervision is being organized by the International Organisation of Pension Supervisors (IOPS) and the Superintendency of Banking, Insurance and Private Pension Funds of Peru and will take place on September 8-9, 2011 in Lima, Peru.

#### **2. VENUE**

#### **3. ACCOMODATION**

Special accomodation rates have been negotiated with the **Miraflores Park Hotel** and other hotels nearby.

Foreign non-resident participants are exempt from the 18% tax for lodging and other service expenses and will be charged only with the 10% tax, if showing their passports at check in time.

Rates are in U.S. Dollars and most of them include breakfast.

Jorge Chavez International Airport of Lima is located 45 minutes from the Miraflores district. Taxi companies are available at the airport with an approximate US\$25 rate. ### **6. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

#### **WEATHER**

During the date of the event, temperatures range will be between 19° C and 15° C, equivalent to 66° F to 59° F.

#### **CURRENCY**

Peru's local currency is the Nuevo Sol. The exchange rate is around S/. 2,8 Nuevos Soles per US \$1.00 American dollar. Foreign currency may be exchanged at hotels or local banks. The US dollar is accepted at most hotels, shops, and restaurants at the daily exchange rate.

Regarding nuevos soles, there are currently in circulation coins for 1, 5, 10, 20 and 50 cents, as well as 1, 2 and 5 nuevos soles and money bills for 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 nuevos soles.

#### **CREDIT CARDS**

In Peru, most of the establishments accept credit cards and the more commonly used are: Visa, Master Card, Diners and American Express. The acceptance of Traveler's Checks is very limited, so it is better to ask the establishment beforehand.

#### **BANKS AND CURRENCY EXCHANGE**

It is advisable to change money at hotels, banks and authorized exchange offices (attention 9:00 h - 18:00 h). On Saturdays, banks open only until noon, except those agencies that are located inside supermarkets or stores. The exchange rate varies, so it is advisable to ask before changing money. It is important to keep coins and small bills to facilitate transactions, especially if you require to take a cab or do purchases in small stores.

#### **ATMs**

ATMs in Peru can withdraw cash in soles and U.S. dollars through international credit cards.

### **OFFICE HOURS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS**

Offices hours are from Monday to Friday, from 9:00 to 18:00. Commercial establishments open Monday to Friday from 10:00 to 20:00. On Saturdays and Sundays from 10:00 to 21:00. Large shopping centers are open every day including Saturdays and Sundays.

### **SALES AND SERVICES TAX**

In Peru, the general sales tax is 18%. Sometimes the prices that are indicated in some products do not include the tax, unless specifically instructed. For any purchase done, the seller must hand in a receipt.

### **TIPPING**

Tipping is usually not added to the account. It is a common practice to add 10% of the estimated total bill for the tip.

### **ELECTRICITY**

The electricity is 220 volts, 60 cycles. To use equipment designed for 110 volts a transformer will be needed. In most hotels of four and five stars, 110 volts can be found. Flat shaped prongs on the plugs may need adaptors.

### **MOBILE PHONES**

In Peru there are three mobile phone companies Movistar, Claro and Nextel. Mobile phones brought from abroad will not work unless appropriate modifications have been done in the country of origin.
